

FOCUS ON HOUSING


WE'VE HEARD A LOT ABOUT HOUSING **SO FAR - HELP DIG IN DEEPER!**

HIGHLIGHTS OF WHAT WE'VE BEEN HEARING:

- There is limited housing inventory and high demand at all price points.
- Prevent displacement of current residents.
- More affordable housing.
- Make the path to homeownership easier.
- Address homelessness due to rising housing costs, social service investments.
- Encourage redevelopment of vacant houses and new housing typologies.
- Improve arts and housing connections to keep creatives here.

FOCUS ON CONNECTIVITY


WE'VE HEARD A LOT ABOUT CONNECTIVITY SO FAR - HELP DIG IN DEEPER!

HIGHLIGHTS OF WHAT WE'VE BEEN HEARING:

- Make New Bedford more pedestrianfriendly, walkable, and bikable (traffic calming, bike lanes, etc).
- Invest in all forms of public transit + mobility.
- Add more wayfinding to direct neighborhood walking to community sites.
- Create connections across/among neighborhoods.
- New Bedford should be a city connected by a network of pathways that all can use for transportation and recreation.
- More community facilities and shared community spaces in the neighborhood.


INNOVATION
